### Artist: Elizabeth Castro



**Elizabeth Castro** was born in San Jose, and raised in California's Central Valley. Castro is a multidisciplinary artist—printmaker, sculpture, illustrator, painter, graphic novelist, and art educator. Castro studied Studio Art at CSU Stanislaus. She has sold her work worldwide. Castro currently teaches art through a nonprofit organization.

Castro's work is autobiographical told through mythology. The work is about expression, human condition, taking the ugly and seeing the beauty in it—the hope. Life is short, and

it hurts to see there are people struggling to want to live. This is not a new problem; it's seen through history. I can only help those that are most close to me, or the ones that reach out to me. I ask for others to do the same for those next to them, and expand the web we can make a difference. If we all help just one person. Let's all spread love.

Castro will use a medium she feels works best to express what she is feeling, or seeing. Her work is about expression, and what she sees and feels. It's the human condition. It's a repeated history. It can be seen in stories we read time and again. It's all predictable if you look at the patterns. We can help to change things. Help those that are lost. If you know the stories you can guide the river away to a better route.

*Autumn* is a painting from a series done in August of 2010. The song "Buanderie Jazz" by Automelodi was playing in background. The image on the painting is reference of a photo of 17-18 year old Castro. In the photo Castro is mimicking Lil Dagover's character in *The Cabinet of Dr. Caligari*. The painting was quickly done. She painted tirelessly for a few days, used up all her paint, and canvases in a week. *Autumn*, and *Girl on Train* are only two from the series that still remain in her possession. Castro sold the rest of the series over ten years ago.

At the Rogue Festival, our core belief is that in a free society, arts administrators are not the proper judges of which artists should be allowed to perform or which messages audiences should be allowed to hear. It's not our job to tell anyone what to say, who to listen to, what to hear, or what to think. Our mission as a nonprofit is to empower artists and audiences and to facilitate a direct connection between the two.

We cannot fulfill this mission without our incredible, hardworking, all-volunteer staff. The Rogue Festival is an event by and for the community, staffed by your friends and neighbors who work hard to bring the Rogue back year after year. If you like what you see at the Rogue—or even more important, you see ways we can improve—come join us and volunteer for Rogue 2025. We need more lovely people like YOU to make this happen.

I would like to thank our staff, all our artists, our wonderful venues, our generous sponsors, and above all, you, the audience. Please see as many shows as you can, patronize our fantastic Tower District bars and restaurants, review shows on our website, and experience something new!

# How to Rogue

## (It's easier than it looks)

- 1. Get a Rogue wristband. A Rogue wristband is required for entry to EVERY Rogue performance.** Rogue wristbands cost just \$6. You can buy your Rogue wristband on the Rogue website, at any Rogue venue, or at The Rogue Store, located in the Component Coffee/Lotus Room parking lot.
- 2. Buy tickets with credit/debit at the door or online.** You can purchase tickets to any performance with credit or debit at the door, starting 30 minutes before the performance. Or you can buy tickets in advance at [roguefestival.ticketleap.com](http://roguefestival.ticketleap.com).
- 3. If you want to pay cash, buy Rogue Vouchers at The Rogue Store.** Rogue-managed venues only accept credit, debit, and Rogue Vouchers. Cash is accepted only at The Rogue Store. Off-Rogue venues (Hart's Haven, LAByrinth) accept credit, debit, cash, and Rogue Vouchers. Artists Underground Venues (2nd Space Theatre and Stargazer Cottage) accept credit, debit, and cash, but not Rogue Vouchers.
- 4. Or buy a 10-show ticket.** If you're going to do a lot of Rogueing, buy a 10-Show Ticket and save up to \$30! A 10-Show Ticket costs \$120, and is available at The Rogue Store.
- 5. Arrive early. All Rogue performances start ON TIME.** Some Rogue shows allow latecomers to enter up to 15 minutes after the start time. Other Rogue shows do not allow latecomers at all. (Show listings will tell you if latecomers are allowed.)
- 6. No, seriously, arrive *early*! All seating is general seating.** Your ticket guarantees you a seat, but not a specific seat.
- 7. Turn off your @\$%! cell phone!** Be courteous to performers and audience—please silence your ringer and don't talk, text, or take photos during the show. But we'd love it if you mention great shows on social media! Use our hashtag, [#roguefestival](https://twitter.com/roguefestival).
- 8. Post a review.** Did you love it? Did you hate it? Either way, our performers want to hear from you. Post your review at [fresnoroguefestival.org](http://fresnoroguefestival.org).
- 9. Buy Rogue tchotchkes!** Buy attractive and collectible Rogue T-shirts, buttons, and wristbands at The Rogue Store.
- 10. Be safe.** Take sensible precautions while enjoying the Rogue Festival. Lock your vehicle. Store valuables in your trunk. Don't walk alone at night.
